The Dayton Police Department and the Montgomery County Combined Agency OVI Task Force will operate two sobriety checkpoints on Friday, Aug. 22, from 7 p.m. to 12 a.m.

The checkpoint locations are as follows: The first will be in the area of South Main Street and West Stewart Street; the second will be in the area of South Patterson Boulevard and West Stewart Street.

The OVI task force aims to reduce the number of alcohol/drug-related traffic crashes, injuries, and fatalities in Dayton and Montgomery County. Sobriety checkpoints help deter impaired driving, and they aid in the apprehension of impaired drivers who choose to get behind the wheel and drive.
