



Kettering Field construction underway

The City of Dayton Department of Recreation announces that planned improvements at Kettering Field (444 N. Bend Blvd.) are now under construction. During construction, certain areas will be closed to the public, for safety purposes.

Visitors are asked to avoid fenced-off sections, cone-marked areas, and any spaces that are visibly under construction.

Upgrades at Kettering Field include new or improved athletic fields, synthetic turf surfaces, pickleball courts, tennis courts, and improved lighting, seating and parking areas.

Construction is scheduled to continue over the next year, with an estimated completion date of August 2026. Updates will be shared as progress is made.

The City of Dayton appreciates the community's patience and cooperation as we work to enhance Kettering Field for future recreation use.
