The Dayton Mediation Center celebrates its rich 38-year history of providing free and low-cost conflict intervention services to the greater Dayton area, serving our vision and mission of providing non-violent processes for responding constructively to conflicts.

The Dayton Mediation Center, through partnership with its volunteers who serve as mediators, community impact panelists, Advisory Board members, receptionist/administrative support, and ambassadors have helped community members receiving conflict intervention services from the Dayton Mediation Center turn **conflict into conversation** since 1987!

In 2025, Mediation will provide conflict intervention services for approximately 6,500 cases involving over 9,000 community members. The Mediation Center has 70 active volunteers that serve as mediators, panelists, board members, and administrative support.
