



## **Miyah Bayless named Division of Water Supply and Treatment manager**

City Manager Shelley Dickstein announces the promotion of Miyah Bayless to the position of manager of the Division of Water Supply and Treatment at the City of Dayton Department of Water.

As division manager, Bayless will oversee a treatment and distribution network providing 23.4 billion gallons of water yearly to approximately 400,000 residents and businesses in Dayton and much of Montgomery County.

The Division of Water Supply and Treatment has 121 employees and an annual budget (2025) of \$36 million. Its facilities and assets include two water treatment plants, two developed well fields, 16 storage facilities, a lime reclamation facility, and a water quality laboratory.

Bayless joined the Department of Water in 2010 and has served as a bacteriological chemist, research and control specialist, acting plant manager, and other positions. She has served as water treatment technical supervisor since January of 2025.

She earned a B.S. in Chemistry at Bowling Green State University (2003) and two Ohio EPA Class III Water Operator certifications (Water and Wastewater).

"Miyah Bayless has demonstrated leadership and excellence in technical and management areas, and we are happy she will continue to contribute her abilities to benefit the Dayton community," Dickstein said. "Her work with the City of Dayton is an example of the variety and quality of careers the City can offer."
