



## February 7 Is Super Refund Saturday

Super Refund Saturday, the annual event offering free tax return preparation and filing by IRS-trained volunteers, will be held on Saturday, Feb. 7, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Montgomery County Job Center, 1111 S. Edwin C. Moses Blvd. in Dayton.

Volunteers from KeyBank, Miami Valley Urban League and the City of Dayton will host the event, which is focused on working families and individuals taking advantage of the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) and Child Tax Credit (CTC).

While scheduled appointments are recommended, volunteers may accommodate a limited number of walk-ins (please arrive by 2 p.m.). Call 937-913-2000 to schedule an appointment. Participants are asked to use the orange Job Center entrance.

The EITC and CTC are two of the nation's largest anti-poverty programs, helping to lift over six million people out of poverty each year, including more than three million children. The tax credits are more valuable than ever, ranging from \$649 for workers with no dependents to \$7,830 for some families. Eligible taxpayers must file a federal tax return in order to claim the credits.

Each year, thousands of qualifying Americans do not claim the EITC on federal income tax returns, meaning billions of dollars in much-needed refunds go unclaimed. Super Refund Saturday is a cost-effective way for tax filers to navigate the tax preparation process and ensure they are getting their full benefit. If participating in Super Refund Saturday, taxpayers should bring these documents (including spouse's documents if filing jointly):

- State-issued photo ID
- Social Security card (for you, your spouse, and each child and/or dependent)
- W-2 forms
- 1099 forms (interest, earnings as an independent contractor)
- Unemployment forms (if applicable)
- Proof of childcare payments
- Other IRS forms as appropriate
- Last year's tax return (if available)
- Bank account and routing number for direct deposit (if applicable).
