The Dayton Police Department, along with members of the Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County, will operate a sobriety checkpoint tonight at 8 p.m. near the intersection of North Main Street and Hillcrest Avenue, followed by the area of Salem Avenue at Hillcrest Avenue.
