

Police seek help with hit-and-run investigation

The Dayton Police Department Crash Reconstruction Unit is asking for the public's assistance with a hit-and-run investigation.

The incident happened on Dec. 25, 2018, just before 7 p.m., in the 100 block of Dearborn Avenue (near McCall Street), when a vehicle struck a pedestrian and fled the scene.

The pedestrian was in serious condition and remains hospitalized. The hit-and-run vehicle is described as possibly an SUV, dark in color, with four doors and tinted windows. The vehicle would have damage to the right front side and a broken right headlight.
