The Living City Project, a volunteer-led community cleanup event on Saturday, April 6, will focus on removing litter and debris at vacant home lots in

neighborhoods across the city of Dayton. Clean-up work will occur in at least 25 neighborhoods, from 8:30 a.m. to noon.

Additional volunteers are needed for the clean-up effort. Interested residents are asked to register by April 1 at daytonohio.gov/livingcity.

Volunteers should arrange for their own transportation;



information will be provided on locations for volunteer crews to meet. Bags and litter pickers will be provided, but volunteers are asked to bring work gloves.

The Living City Project is organized by the Church of Greater Dayton, with assistance from the City of Dayton and support from community sponsors. The <u>Dayton Inspires initiative has produced a video</u> about the project.
