The City of Dayton is seeking interested community volunteers to support the revitalization of the North Main Street corridor and surrounding neighborhoods.

The North Main Street Corridor Plan was adopted by the City Commission in December 2018. It outlines eight areas of concern related to North Main Street and associated neighborhoods:

1. Crime & safety
2. Housing & blight
3. Traffic & pedestrian safety
4. Land use and zoning
5. Economic development
6. Citizen engagement & neighborhood development
7. Social services, education & recreation
8. Architecture & preservation.
