



Mayor Whaley elected to U.S. Conference of Mayors leadership position

Dayton Mayor Nan Whaley was elected as second vice-president of the United States Conference of Mayors during the organization's 87th Annual Meeting last weekend. This position puts Whaley in line to become president of the conference in 2021.

Whaley has served on the Conference's Board of Trustees since 2016, and has held leadership positions as chair of the International Affairs Committee and as co-chair of the Substance Abuse Task Force with Boston Mayor Marty Walsh.

"I'm so honored to take on this new responsibility as a leader among my peer mayors," said Whaley. "I have found the Conference to be a tremendous opportunity to learn from other mayors and bring resources back to Dayton."

At the annual meeting, Mayor Bryan Barnett of Rochester Hills, Mich., was elected Conference president, and Mayor Greg Fischer of Louisville was elected vice president.
