



## **Dennis Thomas Named Facilities Division Manager**

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City Manager Shelley Dickstein has announced the appointment of Dennis Thomas to the position of Manager of the Division of Facilities Management, effective April 4, 2016.

Thomas will oversee the operation and maintenance of the majority of the City of Dayton's buildings and properties, including City Hall, the One Stop Center (371 W. Second St.), the Ottawa Street Yards on East Monument Avenue, police and fire stations, recreation centers, parking facilities and others.

His responsibilities will include managing facility improvements, supervision of facilities employees and implementation of strategic initiatives including energy savings and modernization.

Thomas joined the City of Dayton in 2015, serving as Support Services Administrator in the Fire Department. Previously, he worked as a business consultant and in facility and services management for Sodexo, Inc., from 2003 to 2012. He earned B.S. and M.S. degrees at Northern Kentucky University, studying Industrial and Labor Relations, Organizational Studies and Executive Leadership/Organizational Change.

As Division Manager Thomas replaces Romona Carver, who retired after 28 years of City of Dayton employment.
