



Nominations accepted for the annual Joseph T. Cline Award

Nominations are now being accepted for the Cline Award, honoring City of Dayton employees for excellence in public service.

The award, named in honor of civic volunteer Joseph T. Cline, recognizes employees who display extraordinary dedication in their work. Other civic and community involvement may also be considered. Honorees receive a cash award from an endowment established by the Cline family, through The Dayton Foundation.

To be eligible, a nominee must be a current full-time or permanent part-time employee, with a minimum of two years of City of Dayton employment.

Nominations must be received by 5 p.m. on Friday, Oct. 25, 2019. Honorees will be chosen by a selection committee made up of representatives from The Dayton Foundation, the City of Dayton administration and the Priority Land Use Boards, as well as prior Cline Award winners.
