



## Free tax preparation, instant filing at Feb. 1 Super Saturday event

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Low- and moderate-income taxpayers claiming the federal Earned Income Tax Credit and/or Child Tax Credit can get free tax return preparation and instant filing at "Super Refund Saturday" on Feb. 1, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m., at the Montgomery County Job Center (1111 S. Edwin C. Moses Blvd.).

Tax returns will be prepared and filed by IRS-trained volunteers. Taxpayers are asked to bring appropriate documents including a photo ID and W-2s.

Super Refund Saturday is presented by the Dayton Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Coalition and KeyBank. The Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit are two of the nation's largest anti-poverty programs, helping lift millions of workers and children out of poverty each year. The tax credits are more valuable than ever, ranging from \$529 for workers with no dependents to \$6,557 for some families. Eligible taxpayers must file a federal income tax return in order to claim the credits.

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
