



## Updated: Training Session dates

### Neighborhoods may apply for mini-grants for special projects

*Release date: Monday, Feb. 24, 2020*

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The City of Dayton neighborhood mini-grant application process for 2020 is underway.

Mini-grants of up to \$5,000 may be awarded for projects and programs benefiting neighborhoods, such as physical improvements, marketing materials, community events, and other initiatives benefiting the community and increasing organizational capacity.

Neighborhood associations, block clubs, priority boards and other community groups already established and having a public purpose are welcome to apply. Recipient organizations are required to use grant funds to leverage a fifty percent match from other sources and in-kind contributions.

Training sessions for interested groups will be held at the Northwest Recreation Center, 1600 Princeton Dr., on Saturday, April 18, at 10 a.m., or Monday, April 20, at 5:30 p.m. After attending a training session, applications will be sent to attendees on May 1. Attendance of a training session by applicants is mandatory.
