The Dayton Police Department is proud to welcome 16 new officers this week. The members of the 109th Dayton police recruit class will be sworn-in and graduate on Friday, April 24, at 10 a.m., in the City Commission Chambers at City Hall (101 W. Third St., second floor). Montgomery County Prosecutor Mathias Heck will provide the keynote address.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the directives on large gatherings, the graduation ceremony will not be open to the public. Only those necessary for the ceremony will attend, in order to adhere to social distancing guidelines.

Members of the 109th recruit class completed more than six months of rigorous training and classroom work at the Dayton Police Academy. Upon graduation, the new officers will be assigned to a patrol training officer for 16 weeks before beginning patrol duties on their own.
