The Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County will operate a sobriety checkpoint in Dayton on Friday, May 22. The location will be announced on May 22.

The OVI checkpoint and enhanced patrols during the weekend are an effort of law enforcement agencies to deter and to apprehend impaired drivers. Dayton Police officers, along with officers from the Combined Agency Task Force, will conduct the checkpoint.

During this period law enforcement officers, both locally and nationally, will also be looking for drivers not wearing their seatbelts. The national "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" campaign is underway.
