The Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County will operate two sobriety checkpoints in Dayton on Thursday, June 25.

The checkpoint will occur from 8 p.m. to 12 a.m., in the area of South Smithville Road and Linden Avenue.

The goal of the OVI Task Force is to reduce the number of alcohol/drug related traffic crashes, injuries and fatalities in Dayton and Montgomery County. Sobriety checkpoints help deter impaired driving and aid in the apprehension of impaired drivers who make the choice to get behind the wheel and drive.

In 2019, there were 584 alcohol-related and 236 drug-related crashes in Montgomery County, 13 of which were fatal.
