



## **Commission to join police reform cross-group meeting**

The Dayton City Commission will join a cross-group meeting of the five working groups of the Dayton police reform initiative on Friday, Jan. 8. Commissioners will participate beginning at 5 p.m. The meeting will be held remotely and will be available to watch live at [daytonohio.gov/govtv](http://daytonohio.gov/govtv). This meeting is being held in accordance with changes to both state and local laws regarding public meetings during a state of emergency. In response to COVID-19 and in the interest of public health and welfare, Governor DeWine signed an emergency declaration on March 9, 2020, and the City of Dayton followed with an emergency proclamation on March 12, 2020. On March 25, 2020, the Ohio legislature passed Amended Sub House Bill 197, which in Section 12(B) allows for public meetings and hearings to be conducted by electronic means.
