



Nominations accepted for the Joseph T. Cline Awards

Nominations are now being accepted for the annual Joseph T. Cline Awards honoring City of Dayton employees for excellence in public service.

The awards, named for civic volunteer Joseph T. Cline, recognize employees who demonstrate extraordinary dedication in their work. Other civic and community involvement may also be considered. To be eligible, a nominee must be a current full-time or permanent part-time employee, with a minimum of two years of City of Dayton employment.

Nominations must be received by 5 p.m. on Friday, October 22, 2021, and may be submitted at daytonohio.gov/clineawards. Nomination forms may also be picked up or returned at City Hall (101 W. Third St., main lobby).

Award winners will be chosen by a selection committee made up of representatives of The Dayton Foundation and the City of Dayton, a community volunteer, and prior winners. Honorees receive a cash award from an endowment established by the Cline family, through The Dayton Foundation.

The Dayton Foundation is the regional community foundation for greater Dayton. Since 1921, the Foundation has helped people to help others, managing charitable funds that have provided grants totaling over a half-billion dollars to non-profit organizations.
