



Funeral Procession to Honor Officer Michael Saylor

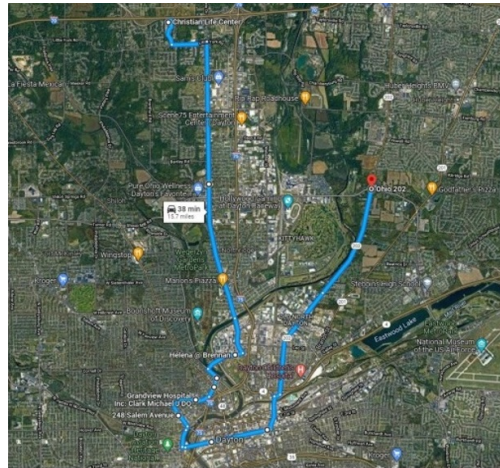

The Dayton Police Department will provide a funeral with police honors for Officer Michael Saylor, who died earlier this month after a brave battle with cancer.

Officer Saylor's funeral will begin at 11am on Thursday, February 24 at the Christian Life Center (3489 Little York Rd). At the conclusion of the service, there will be a procession that will go through the downtown area and past the Safety Building before making its way back to the funeral home.

We expect the procession to begin sometime between 12:45-1:00pm. There will not be any road closures, but major intersections will be affected as the procession of funeral vehicles and police vehicles makes their way through. There may be some traffic delays in parts of Butler Township, Vandalia, Harrison Township, Riverside, and the City of Dayton during this time.



Officer Saylor dedicated 22 years of service to the people of Dayton as a patrol officer, most recently as a member of the East Patrol Community Problem Response Team. We appreciate your understanding as we honor his life and service.
