The City of Dayton Department of Recreation is offering a series of three courses leading to American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification. The series must be completed during one of the following date ranges: March 21-23; March 28-30; or April 11-13 (8 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day). All classes are held at the Northwest Recreation Center (1600 Princeton Dr.). Interested candidates must be at least 15 years old and able to swim front crawl and breaststroke. The fee is \$200 unless going to work as a lifeguard for the City of Dayton, in which case the fee is waived. Dayton Rec is also seeking paid interns for the Urban Adventures Summer Camps. Interns will work camp for eight weeks, with pre-training and post-cleanup work. The work schedule will be 40 hours weekly, Monday-Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. The pay is \$11.50/hr. Applicants must be graduating from high school and enrolled in a two- or four-year college for the fall of 2022 or be a current college student.
