

Neighborhoods may apply for mini-grants for special projects

The City of Dayton neighborhood mini-grant application process for 2022 is underway.

Mini-grants of up to \$5,000 may be awarded for projects and programs benefiting neighborhoods, such as physical improvements, marketing materials, community events, and other initiatives benefiting the community and increasing organizational capacity.

Neighborhood associations, block clubs, priority boards and business associations, and other community groups already established and having a public purpose are welcome to apply. Recipient organizations are required to use grant funds to leverage a fifty percent match from other sources and in-kind contributions.

Required training sessions for interested groups will be held at the Dayton Metro Library, 215 E. Third St., on March 24, March 31, April 7, April 14, and April 19, 2022. After attending the workshops, applications will be sent to attendees on May 9. Attendance of all five workshops by applicants is mandatory.
