A graduation ceremony will also take place Friday, June 17, at 6 p.m., at Stivers School for the Arts Eichelberger Hall (1313 E. Fifth St.). Montgomery County Recorder Brandon McClain will provide the keynote address.

Members of the 111th recruit class completed more than six months of rigorous training and classroom work at the Dayton Police Academy. Upon graduation, the new officers will be assigned to a field training officer for 16 weeks before beginning patrol duties on their own.
