



## Sept. 22 sobriety checkpoint details announced

The Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County will operate a sobriety checkpoint in Dayton on Thursday, Sept. 22, from 6 p.m. to 11 p.m., in the area of East Third Street at Terry Street, followed by South Keowee Street at East Fifth Street.

From January 2018 through March 2022, there were 2,633 OVI-related crashes in Montgomery County (with 533 in the city of Dayton). The majority of the deadliest crashes occur throughout the weekends.

Operational support for the checkpoint will be provided by law enforcement officers of the Combined Agency OVI Task Force of Montgomery County, including the Dayton Police Department.
