



Dayton Survey arriving in homes, City encourages resident response

The City of Dayton is seeking residents' opinions about living in Dayton and City government.

The annual Dayton Survey began arriving at approximately 9,000 randomly selected homes during the week of Sept. 19.

Residents should look for an envelope showing the City of Dayton logo and the message "Help the City of Dayton serve you better by taking this survey!".

The survey consists of approximately 80 questions covering a broad assortment of City services, programs and priorities, as well as quality-of-life issues in neighborhoods. Participation is anonymous. The survey is also offered in Spanish.

Residents receiving the mailed survey can return a completed survey in the postage-paid envelope by Oct. 14 or may complete the survey using the web address indicated in the survey letter.

Mayor Jeffrey J. Mims, Jr., is asking residents receiving the survey letter to respond: "Make your voice heard by participating in the 2022 Dayton Survey. We strongly encourage residents to provide feedback on City services, policies, and the Dayton community. Your responses will help influence and inform City programs and initiatives for all Dayton residents."

The City of Dayton has surveyed residents for more than three decades.

New in 2022: The Dayton Survey administrator, ETC Institute, will randomly select one survey respondent to receive a \$500 VISA gift card for returning a completed survey. The drawing will occur after the survey window is closed and the winner will be contacted by ETC.
