The Dayton Police Department is looking for its next class of police recruits and will present a Safety Forces Expo on Thursday, October 27, for those interested in becoming a Dayton police officer. This interactive event will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. outside Welcome Stadium (1601 S. Edwin C. Moses Blvd.).

The expo is presented for people interested in learning more about what the Dayton Police Department has to offer and about the recruit application and testing process.

The event will feature members of the following special units: Special Weapons and Tactics (S.W.A.T.), hostage negotiations, forensic services, bomb squad, K9 handlers, crash reconstruction, and motorcycles. These units will demonstrate some of their equipment and vehicles, and visitors will have opportunities to try out some of the gear. Potential recruits will also be able to speak with officers and special unit members about their work.
