The Dayton Police Department is proud to welcome its newest officers.

Twenty-eight members of the 106th police recruit class will be sworn-in by City Manager Shelley Dickstein on Thursday, August 31, at 10:30 a.m. in the City Commission chambers (101 W. Third St., second floor).

The 106th recruit class will also take part in a formal graduation ceremony later that evening at 6 p.m. at Centennial Hall at Stivers School for the Arts (1313 E. Fifth St.). The keynote speaker is Montgomery County Prosecutor Mathias Heck, Jr.

The graduates of the recruit class completed six months of rigorous training at the Dayton Police Academy. Upon graduation, the new officers will be assigned to a field training officer for 16 weeks before beginning patrol duties on their own.

Friends, family, and the community are invited to attend the swearing in and the graduation ceremonies.
