| <b>Neighborhood Watch</b>                                    | A program of systematic local vigilance by residents of a neighborhood, to discourage crime.   | Crime Prevention    |
| <b>NextDoor</b>  | A private website designed just for neighbors to keep in touch and share information.  | Crime Prevention    |
| <b>Report It (LEADS Online)</b>                              | Program which lets you securely store serial numbers, item descriptions, pictures, etc.,so these items may be more easily identified in the event of theft or loss.                          | Crime Prevention    |

| <b>Women's Self Defense</b>                         | Basic women's self defense.  | Educational Courses |

| <b>Refugee Training: Police 101</b>                 | Training provided to refugees regarding police interaction and other concerns, to assist them in having a successful integration into our community. Week long class done 2-3 times per year | Immigrant Outreach  |
| <b>Anti-Bullying Presentation</b>                   | Training for students given to deter bullying.   | Juvenile Programs   |
| <b>Basketball (Police vs. Students)</b>             | Outreach program pitting police officers vs. students in friendly game of basketball.  | Juvenile Programs   |
| <b>Bike Safety Rodeo</b>                            | Designed to teach youth proper bicycle safety (citywide event).  | Juvenile Programs   |
| <b>Camp Mariposa</b>                                | Different specialized units meet with students in Camp Mariposa to learn about the police and the different units that we offer.   | Juvenile Programs   |
| <b>Freedom School (Police &amp; Youth Together)</b> | Partnership with NCCJ Police & Youth Together and the Wesleyan & Dakota Centers' Summer Freedom School (six-week program).   | Juvenile Programs   |

| <b>Mural Painting</b>           | Murals throughout the city painted on buildings as part of neighborhood revitalization program.   | Neighborhood Focus |
| <b>Neighborhood Clean-Ups</b>   | Neighborhood revitalization where dumped materials are removed, vacant properties are mowed, and shrubbery is trimmed. Montgomery County Jail will provide workers and juvenile court will also help. | Neighborhood Focus |
| <b>Walk-the-Block</b>           | Partnership with the Dayton Police Department and other City departments to walk neighborhoods to document and resolve community issues.  | Neighborhood Focus |
