

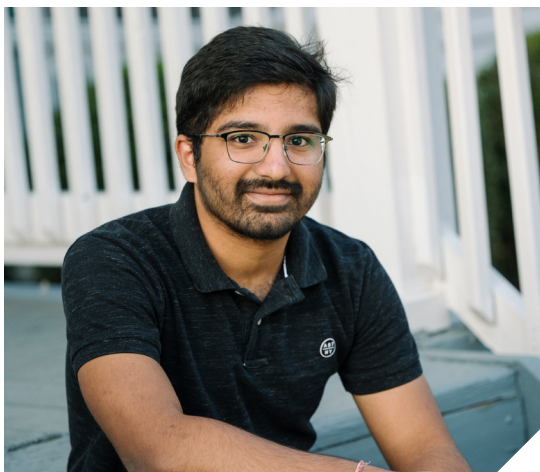

# INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM

The Intensive English Program offers students the opportunity to develop the skills needed to take full advantage of the high-quality education the University has to offer—all within a personalized environment. Whatever your background or goals, the University of Dayton will provide you with the highest quality English and cultural program.



The Intensive English Program is a **gateway to undergraduate or graduate admission** or can be used for **language and culture immersion** for personal and professional desires. Most students complete language training in as little as one academic year.



The **four core courses** of the program are Writing/Grammar, Reading/Vocabulary, Oral Communication/Listening Note-Taking, and Special Topics courses. Special topics courses are offered in American Culture and Community and Academic Success.

College and professional preparatory courses teach skills in essay writing, vocabulary development, intensive reading, oral presentation development, note-taking, collaborative learning and group work, critical thinking and research writing.



The **five levels of the program** are designed to rapidly increase the language proficiency and academic skills of students in a short period of time.

Students are placed in the appropriate level based on placement exam scores.

- Pre-academic
- Basic Academic
- Intermediate academic
- Advanced Academic
- Graduate Academic

The University of Dayton Intensive English Program is designed to benefit both degree-seeking students and those who wish to have an English language and American culture immersion experience.

## 1. EARN YOUR DEGREE

Students who plan to continue at the University of Dayton to matriculate at the undergraduate or graduate level should apply for admission to an undergraduate or graduate program.

If you are admitted to the University of Dayton, but you need to improve your English, you will be conditionally admitted and study in the IEP until you are ready for your academic program. After successfully completing the IEP (Advanced Academic for undergraduate; Graduate Academic for graduate), you will be fully admitted to the University with no further need for language proficiency test scores (e.g., TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, etc).

*Note:* Students must also meet any additional admission requirements of the program in which they plan to study.

## 2. CULTURAL IMMERSION

Students who plan to only enroll in the Intensive English Program for language and cultural immersion, and not pursue an academic program, should apply for direct admission to the Intensive English Program.

For those interested in improving their English language skills and learning more about American culture only, the IEP provides many curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular programming designed specifically to meet these needs.

## PROGRAM DATES

The Intensive English Program offers **four 7-week terms** of study per academic year. Full-time students receive 18-21 hours of instruction per week.

**Fall A:** August–October  
**Fall B:** October–December  
**Spring A:** January–March  
**Spring B:** March–May
