Questions and Answers:

QUESTION #1:

I am inquiring to see if you are only considering crane trucks that are ready for immediate delivery or are open to units built to your specifications? In addition, on page 11 of the specification it indicates that there are no substitutions for the Manitex Model 2610C and I would like to know why other brands cannot be considered?

ANSWER #1:

The specification has been limited to the Manitex 2610C because we already operate this model in our fleet and it has demonstrated strong reliability. Past performance is an important factor in our equipment decisions. In addition, maintaining consistency in equipment benefits both our operators and our maintenance staff, as familiarity with the equipment reduces training requirements and improves efficiency. Standardizing on a single brand also allows us to consolidate parts inventory and support resources rather than maintaining multiple systems across the fleet.
