



## SPILL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Owners and operators of businesses are solely responsible for reporting spills. The following list summarizes City of Dayton recommended spill reporting requirements (written reporting obligations may also apply).

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Releases equal to or exceeding the reportable quantity</li> <li>Release in any amount to storm sewer or surface water</li> </ul>	IMMEDIATELY	Fire Department	911
