

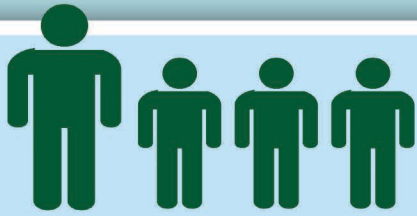
EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT

EITC



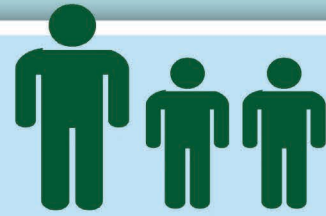
Put extra cash in your pocket!

The earned income credit (EITC or EIC) is a refundable tax credit for low- to moderate-income working individuals and couples, particularly those with children. **You may qualify (SEE GUIDELINES BELOW)!**



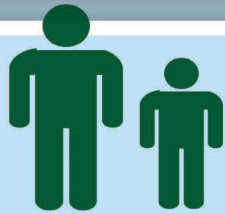
**EITC up to
\$8,046**

If you lived with **three or more children** in 2025 and your family **earned a max of \$61,555 (or a max of \$68,675 for married workers)**, then you can get up to **\$8,046**.



**EITC up to
\$7,152**

If you lived with **two children** in 2025 and your family **earned a max of \$57,310 (or a max of \$64,430 for married workers)**, then you can get up to **\$7,152**.



**EITC up to
\$4,328**

If you lived with **one child** in 2025 and your family **earned a max of \$50,434 (or a max of \$57,554 for married workers)**, then you can get up to **\$4,328**.



**EITC up to
\$649**

If you had **no children** living with you in 2025 and you **earned a max of \$19,104 (or a max of \$26,214 for married workers)**, and you were between the ages 25 and 64, you can get up to **\$649**.

Get Free Help Filing Your Tax Return! Fast Refunds, No Fees!

IRS-trained volunteers are available to help EITC eligible workers fill out their tax forms for free. **Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) sites are open from January 24th through April 15th.**

For information about other FREE tax preparation sites in the Dayton area, call 937-913-2000

You must bring the following items to the tax preparation sites:

- Photo ID
- W-2 Forms for wages earned in 2025
- Social Security (S.S.) cards or Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITIN) for you and all persons in your family included on your tax return
- If you had Child Care expenses in 2025 bring the Provider's S.S. # or Employer ID Number (EIN) and address. Also, bring payment documentation for the total amount you paid to the Provider, and the amount you paid for each child.

- Any correspondence you received from the IRS in 2025 and 1098 & 1099 forms (if any)
- If you want your refund directly deposited into your savings and/ or checking account(s) bring your account number(s) with you to the tax site.
- If you are married filing jointly, both parties must be present in order to process the tax return.
